Generator exhaust systems for years have been fabricated from sections of schedule 40 carbon steel pipe that are field welded, then insulated to reduce surface temperatures.

Check with the generator's manufacturer to determine the optimal cooling method for the system. Factors such as climate and direction of prevailing winds must be considered in an outdoor installation.

Exhaust piping must be terminated safely outside a structure that houses a generator, in such a way that hot gases and sparks will be discharged harmlessly and will not blow against any combustible ...
