

The Ayem&#233; Plaine Solar Power Station is a proposed 120 megawatts solar power plant in Gabon. The power station is under development by Solen, an independent power producer (IPP). The solar farm will be developed in two phases of 60 megawatts each. The energy generated at this power station is expected to be sold to the Energy and Water Company of Gabon (Soci&#233;t&#233; d'Energie et d'Eau du Gabon) (SEEG), for distribution in Libreville, the capital city of the country and its surrounding metropolis.

Gabon has inaugurated its first utility-scale solar project. The Ayem&#233; PV plant is located in the Plaine-Ayeme area of northwestern Gabon, around 30 km from the country's capital, Libreville.
