Solar panels are classified as general cargo and can be transported via sea or air freight. While sea freight is cost-effective for bulk shipments, air freight is faster but more expensive.

On the export front, the EU sent EUR0.9 billion worth of solar panels, EUR2.2 billion in liquid biofuels, and EUR2.0 billion in wind turbines to global markets, Eurostat noted.

Short version: From 2024, it costs between \$2,800 and \$5,500 to ship a 20-foot container of solar panels around the world, depending on origin, destination, fuel prices, and demand.
