

How much does a solar theft cost?

Strecke says European solar thefts typically cause EUR60,000 (\$63,900) of damage, when repairs and loss of business are factored in. "Solar crime is on the increase," says Rachael Oakley, director of crime intelligence at Telford-based DeterTech, formally known as SmartWater Group thanks to its product-marking technology.

How many solar panels can a thief remove?

Viamon's Strecke says organized raiders typically remove 100 panels to 300 solar panels - 10 tons' worth at the top end. In one case, he adds, thieves removed more than 15,000 panels - 5 MW of generation capacity - in one weekend.

How much property was stolen from UK solar sites last year?

Is there a rise in solar theft in 2021 & 2022?
