The Reykjanes power station (known as Reykjanesvirkjun ['rei:ca?n?s?v?r?c?n]) is a geothermal power station located in Reykjanes at the south-western tip of Iceland.

We operate fifteen hydropower stations, three geothermal power stations and two wind turbines for research purposes in five operating areas in Iceland.

The National Power Company (Landsvirkjun) is the largest producer of electricity, which production amount to 12469 GWh or 75% of the total, followed by Reykjavik Energy, which production is 2138 ...
